What is Remote Deposit Capture (RDC)? Remote deposit capture is a technology-based method that allows financial institutions to accept checks for deposit using electronic images instead of the original, physical, paper versions. It means that no matter where you are, you can deposit your check securely with your smartphone into your OCCU account!
